

# The following is a guide that can be used when interviewing child care programs

#### **Basic Information**

Is the program licensed? Is the building safe, clean and well maintained? Is the setting bright and cheerful? Are policies and contracts explained? Is the program nationally accredited? Are caregivers warm and welcoming? Are positive guidance techniques used? Are parents encouraged to be involved in activities? Do the children seem happy? Are teachers trained for the age of the child they care for?

## **Health & Safety**

Are there emergency procedures? Are they posted? How will I be notified in case of an emergency? Are there fire drills/safety plans to follow in an emergency? What is the policy on administering medication? Are all medicines labeled and out of children's reach? What precautions are taken to reduce spread of illness? Are sick children, who are contagious, kept at home? Are toxic items locked and stored safely? Is the room temperature comfortable for children? Are children's/caregiver's hands washed before/after eating?

#### Program

Is the center following the child/teacher care ratio?

Is there stocked first aid kit kept on hand?

Is the classroom decorated with the children's artwork?

Are posters and pictures with captions, cartoons, calendars with special events noted?

During extended periods of the day, can children choose from a variety of available activities?

Do kindergarteners actively exploring materials, doing hand-on activities, working and playing together?

Are children allowed to decribe what they're doing and communicate their ideas?
