Is the program licensed? Is the building safe, clean and well maintained? Is the setting bright and cheerful? Are policies and contracts explained? Is the program nationally accredited?	Are caregives warm and welcoming? Are positive guidance techniques used? Are parents encouraged to be involved in activities? Do children seem happy? Are teachers trained for the age of the child they care for?
Health &	Safety
Are there emergency procedures? Are they posted? How will I be notified in case of an emergency? Are there fire drills/safety plans to follow in an emergency? What is the policy on administering medication? Are all medicines labeled and out of children's reach?	What precautions are taken to reduce spread of illness? Where, and how often the diaper changed? Are toxic items locked and stored safely? Is the room temperature comfortable for children? Are children's/caregiver's hands washed before/after eating?

Does the teacher offer a diverse lesson plan every week? Does the teacher assist in efforts to toilet train your toddler? Do caregivers follow standard health procedures? Does the teacher read to the child at least twice a day? Does the teacher interact with students during the day? Is the play area accesible at all times? omments:	Do toys and materials offer educational and exciting activities? Does the caregiver use positive methods of guidance? Is there a stocked first aid kit kept on hand? Is there daily communication with parents about the child's day? Are play and caregiving routines viewed as learning methods?
