



The following is a guide that can be used when interviewing child care programs

Are caregivers warm and welcoming? Are positive guidance techniques used? Are parents encouraged to be involved in activities? Do infants seem happy? Are teachers trained for the age of the child they care for?
& Safety
What precautions are taken to reduce the spread of illness? Where, and how often are diapers changed? Are toxic items locked and stored safely? Is the room temperature comfortable for children? Are children's/caregiver's hands washed before/after daipering?

Does the caregiver interact with the infant? Is the classroom child-proof? Do caregivers follow standard health procedures? Are there separate crib sheets for each baby in care? Does the program have a first aid kit? Do the caregivers share with parents their infant's progress? Is the caregiver's tone of voice soothing at all times?
