What is a CDA?

The Child Development Associate (CDA) is a nationally recognized credentialing program.

It is a competency-based credential awarded to individuals who work with young children, both as Family Child Care Providers or center-based staff, and have met all of the requirements outlined by the Council for Early Childhood Professional Recognition.

The State of New Jersey, Department of Children and Families (licensing agency) recognizes the credential as equivalent to the Group Teacher Certificate.

How Do I Qualify to be a CDA?

- must be at least 18 years of age.
- must have a High School diploma or GED.
- must have at least 480 hours of experience working with young children, within the past three years.
- must have a minimum of 120 clock hours of formal child care training, which we provide through the CDA classes.
- must be able to speak, read, and write well enough to fulfill the requirements of a CDA candidate.

Where and when can I get CDA Training?

A 10 month CDA program is being offered. Participants can obtain 135 hours of formal training.



Classes will be held every Tuesday night, beginning August 14, 2018 and concluding June 25, 2019.

How Much Does it Cost?
